2025 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ANNOUNCED

The New York Grand Lodge Foundation of the Order Sons of Italy in American has announced its 2025 Scholarship program for undergraduate and graduate study. The New York Grand Lodge Foundation, since the inception of its scholarship program, has distributed over one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in scholarship awards to deserving students. These scholarships were established by Filial Lodges, Districts or individuals and have been subsidized by the Grand Lodge Foundation.

One hundred twenty five (125) scholarships and six (6) grants were awarded in 2024. At the present time, we will once again distribute one hundred twenty five (125) scholarships and six (6) grants to a total of 77 students at a special District site program. Although no students applied for the one Vocational/Trade School Grant we will once again offer it. The monetary award each recipient receives is made payable to the individual and the institution he/she will attend in the fall. Every award recipient will become a Student-Member-At-Large member of the Order.

Requirements for Application:

Undergraduate Awards are for high school graduates of the year 2025 who will begin full-time undergraduate study in the Fall 2025 semester.
 The Creduate Awards are for college graduates of the year 2025 who will begin graduate study in the Fall

The Graduate Awards are for college graduates of the year 2025 who will <u>begin</u> graduate study in the Fall 2025 semester.

- 2. The following must be submitted directly to the District Scholarship Chairperson:
 - Official High School or College transcript, SAT and /or A.C.T. scores and class rank should be included for High School students.
 - Two letters of recommendation from teachers or counselors.
 - A student essay summarizing educational and career goals, school and community service and a discussion of the significance of your Italian heritage.
- 3. The scholarships are awards for academic excellence and service, and students must have an average of 85% or above.
- 4. Applicant must be a resident of New York State and of Italian-American heritage.
- 5. <u>The applications and all supportive materials MUST BE RECEIVED by March 31, 2025</u>.
- 6. An application fee of \$10 MUST BE INCLUDED. Check should be made payable to O.S.I.A. New York State Grand Lodge Foundation.
